KIDS Socioemotional Domain also predicts Grade 3 Test Scores



- Socioemotional development is an important dimension of learning that predicts later academic achievement, graduation, and even college-going.
- Schools contribute to shaping students' socioemotional development.

The three KIDS domains are strongly related to each other


Figure. Overlap in Kindergarten Readiness across KIDS domains



Readiness in SEL, Math, and Language are strongly correlated. This means that most students who are ready in one domain are also ready in the others.

Not Ready in any domain: 41%

KIDS SEL predicts Grade 3 test scores similar to the other KIDS Domains



- Students who are
 Kindergarten Ready are
 more likely to be proficient
 in Grade 3 Math.
- The relationship is similar across domains and subjects.
- This suggests important aspects of emerging development can be measured in many ways.
